- Time limitations
- All skills needed for LCPP
- Didactic considerations

- Conditions for course design
- 2. Available relevant profiles
- 3. Expected domains & situations
- 4. Essential communication situations, contexts & texts
- Expected performance in frequent & demanding situations
- 6. Tasks, exams, and evaluations
