A strong background in psycholinguistic methods as well as expertise in software system development is required. Moreover, a good command of English and German will be expected.

The position is limited to a period of two years. The possibility of an extension into a third year depends upon the availability of additional funding. Salary is according to German public service pay agreement (BAT IIa/2) and will be in the range of  $\ensuremath{\in} 1250$  to  $\ensuremath{\in} 2100$  per month depending on age and family size. The weekly working time is 20 hours. Beyond their project related obligations applicants are given an opportunity to work on their doctoral studies.
